

## **Car registration**

For the car registration at the Vehicle Registration Office (Ger. "Kfz-Zulassungstelle") you need:
<ul><li>License Certificate Part I (registration document, "Zulassungsbescheinigung Teil I")</li></ul>
<ul> <li>License Certificate Part II (identification document, "Zulassungsbescheinigung Teil II")</li> </ul>
$\hfill \square$ eVB Number (electronic insurance confirmation, you get it from your car insurance)
For the registration of used vehicles, additionally
<ul><li>☐ HU (general inspection) and AU (exhaust test) report</li><li>☐ Old license plate (if the vehicle had been registered somewhere else)</li></ul>

You can register your car at the vehicle registration office in your area. The address and opening hours can be found, in most cases, on the website of your local council (Ger. "Stadtverwaltung"). You are also allowed to have your car registered by a third person who has a power of attorney. If you buy a car in Germany, car registration is often done by the car dealer.
